


Notice inviting expression of interest

Archaeological Survey of India desires to set up a personality museum in its centrally protected monument namely the ancestral house of Dr. Rajendra Prasad, the first President of India, located at Jiradei, district Siwan (Bihar). In accordance thereof, Expression of Interest is invited from suitable agencies which are willing to set up a museum at the said site **with its own financial and technical resources** under the overall supervision of Archaeological Survey of India.

The interested agencies should submit online the detailed concept plan along with proposed lay out and designs, the timeline of its completion which should be as short as possible and the quantity of fund to be invested by them along with an explicit statement of willingness to bear the entire cost of project implementation. While conceptualizing the project it should be kept in mind that no change/modification to the original structure is allowed.
